Here are ways in which you are currently most likely to contract or pass around the Covid 19 virus:

The Centre for Disease Control notes that it may be possible for COVID-19 to spread in other ways, but these are not thought to be the main ways the virus spreads. This conclusion comes primarily from epidemiological data—tracking ways in which the majority of the people that were infected became infected. This means you must continue to practice safety measures and good hygiene, especially when you're out in highly crowded places like grocery stores. The most important precaution is wearing a face mask and keeping a safe social distance from others at all times.

Also, Keep washing your hands frequently and be mindful of touching your face.
